Health and Safety Rules for your child and other adults attending sports physicals:

Your child MUST be scheduled on the calendar to be examined for the sports physical.

Your child will remain in the parking lot, in his/her vehicle, while waiting for the physical exam. This will maintain social distancing and provide for the safety of students.

An adult attendant will be in the parking lot and will let you know when it is your child's time/turn to enter the physician's office. Please understand, the times are estimates and the physicals will be moved along at the physician's pace.

Your child must wear a mask. Your child must wear shorts and a T-shirt, **SOCKS AND SHOES**. **No flip flops will be allowed**.

Please understand, this is a courtesy extended to the athletes of the Allegheny Valley School District. Rules and recommendations from the Allegheny Health Department will be followed and enforced. If, for any reason, you feel your child will not be able to safely comply with the rules and procedures, you may have your child examined by his/her own physician. All students will be expected to follow the guidelines.
