

Mission Statement

To recognize, celebrate, and honor those alumni who have distinguished themselves through public service, academic achievement, and professional contributions which serve to enhance the prestige and excellence of the Allegheny Valley School District.

Nomination Criteria

The nominee must:

- 1. Have attended school in the Allegheny Valley School District.
- 2. Be able to be identified as an outstanding member of his/her profession.
- 3. Be an exemplary model for others.
- 4. Have provided a meaningful contribution to the service of others.
- 5. Continue to emphasize self-improvement and life-long learning.

In addition:

- A period of 10 years beyond his/her graduation year must have elapsed in order for a nominee to be considered for entry into the Alumni Hall of Fame.
- The nominee may be living or deceased.

Miscellaneous

- A person attending school in the area prior to the formation of the school district may be included as an alumnus if he/she attended school within the boundaries of the current Allegheny Valley School District.
- No more than seven (7) nominees may be selected for the Alumni Hall of Fame in any given year.
- If a part of the nomination form is not included or answered, the nominee will not be considered for the Hall of Fame.

Rules for Choosing Judges

Judges will be chosen by the district's Public Relations Director using the following guidelines:

- A Panel of five (5) judges will be chosen for every 25 nomination forms received.
- Judges will represent the community as follows:
 (1) selected from the Allegheny Valley School District Staff, (1) current student or a student who has graduated within the last 10 years, (3) chosen from the school district community-at-large representing different age groups.
- After the inaugural year, one of the judges representing the community will be an Alumni Hall of Fame member.
- All judges will be volunteers selected by the Public Relations Director or administrator of the Alumni Hall of Fame program.
- Names of the judges will not be released.

Scoring

- All five judges will score each nomination form in their group of 25 using a rubric put together by the development committee.
- From the final selection scores, District administrators will determine the number of nomiees to be inducted, decide any possible ties, and resolve any disputes.
- The decision of the judges is final.

It is important that (1) you specifically identify the nominee's career, and (2) you understand that standard advancement or career progression due to established procedure does not constitute outstanding career recognition; an individual must go above and beyond normal advancement procedures.
2. Describe how your candidate has impacted the lives of others both in and out of his/her career to inspire them to have a positive impact on society.
3. Describe ways in which your candidate has made a meaningful contribution to the service of others. Please understand that there is a difference between what an organization accomplishes and what an individual accomplishes. It is necessary to describe specific activities that your nominee has taken part in and accomplished for the good of the community that go beyond membership in social organizations that aid community members.
4. Explain how your candidate is a life-long learner and exhibits this quality as part of his/her daily life.
5. Describe why this person deserves to be inducted into the Alumni Hall of Fame. (This information should be an overview of the outstanding qualities of your candidate. Subjective praise - as opposed to documented accomplishments - may not be enough to distinguish the candidate.)
