☑ The Allegheny Valley School District announced this week that students will be returning to the buildings for Hybrid Instruction in-person learning beginning **Tuesday**, **January 19.** As a reminder, Group A attends school in person on Mondays/ Thursdays and Group B attends school in person on Tuesdays/Fridays. All students will attend school remotely on Wednesdays.


☑ In order to return to in-person learning, the District signed an Attestation that ensures implementation of mitigation efforts for COVID-19. This document states that the District will comply with orders from Pennsylvania Department of Health on universal face coverings, exceptions, and associated guidance and will follow the recommendations for Pre-K to 12 schools following identification of a case/cases of COVID-19. The recommendations include the District begin a rolling tracking of COVID cases within the District. Information will be available on the District web site, under COVID-19 Information tab on the homepage.

Parents are encouraged to contact the District's School Nurse, Ms. Kandi Conner directly, <a href="mailto:kconner@avsd.k12.pa.us">kconner@avsd.k12.pa.us</a>, to report positive cases of COVID-19 that directly affect their child. This information includes if the child has tested positive, has symptoms related to COVID, and/or if the child has been exposed and will need to quarantine.

## COVID-19 Information:

The Allegheny Valley School District no longer sends individual emails regarding positive COVID-19 cases. The District now reports all positive cases on a weekly basis through this newsletter. Allegheny Valley is also adding updated information to its website with a new COVID-19 Tracker, which will be updated on a weekly basis for any new cases reported. Cases attributed to the school are identified in the Tracker and are useful in considering if and when schools will close. Cases attributed to the schools are cases where an individual was contagious while in school or was exposed to a known positive COVID-19 individual in the school.

The District also asks if your child is symptomatic or may have been in close contact with a positive case he/she needs to stay home. Parents are asked to contact the school nurse immediately with information on a positive case or COVID symptoms. The District stresses the importance of contacting the School Nurse directly. Ms. Kandi Conner serves as the District's School Nurse (<a href="mailto:kconner@avsd.k12.pa.us">kconner@avsd.k12.pa.us</a> or 724-274-8888 (office) or 724-900-5443 (hotline)). Your cooperation with sharing information with the nurse and reporting any positive cases of COVID-19 within your family or close contacts is very important.

All District schools will remain open as personnel closely monitor the weekly COVID-19 cases within the District.
