The Allegheny Valley School District has scheduled a School-Community Night for Thursday, January 14. COVID HEALTH ALERT

The Allegheny Valley School District was notified after the Holiday Break that additional staff and students have tested positive for COVID-19. None of the individuals have been in the buildings for more than a week; the cases are unrelated and do not suggest school community spread. With the District continuing to hold education on a remote format, District officials still believe it is prudent and responsible to communicate these illnesses to the school community.

Please understand, that the District has an obligation to the health, safety, and welfare of all members of our community AND an obligation to protect the privacy of individuals affected. Therefore, Allegheny Valley will not release the names of anyone affected by the virus.

In addition, to provide timely and up-to-date information regarding COVID-19 cases, Health Alerts will include a summary report. Please remember, when COVID-19 cases are confirmed in the District, notification is sent to the appropriate members of the school community regarding contact tracing and steps taken following the guidance of the Allegheny County Health Department. We believe this report will be helpful as we move forward.
