To provide additional communication for families on the re-opening of school, this short newsletter will be available each Friday.

Notes from Dr. Graczyk:

After many discussions about when to return to the "normal" school routine, I would like to share my suggested course of action for the next phase of reopening. We anticipate bringing back all students who are able to return to school for 5-day a week instruction on **October 26**. We will be extending the Hybrid Phase until then to allow additional time for rearranging classrooms, working with the bus company, monitoring local metrics, addressing staffing issues, and transitioning students and staff to the In-person Traditional Phase with health/safety precautions. Additional considerations:

The Traditional Phase:

- Student drop off and pick up will create an abbreviated student day because many parents are providing transportation.
- Large gatherings are to be avoided.
- Masks or face shields will be required unless a medical excuse is provided.
- Social Distancing will be to the maximum extent possible and will rarely be 6 feet. So that students can remove their masks, seating at lunches will need to be 6-feet apart.
- Concerns that necessitate action might trigger a prolonged stay in the Hybrid Phase instead of being able to move to the Traditional Phase.

Staffing: The District is currently short-staffed, and substitutes are difficult to find, in several areas of our organization (teachers/custodians)

Metrics: Spikes of COVID in Allegheny County might precipitate an inability to move to the In-person Traditional Phase.
