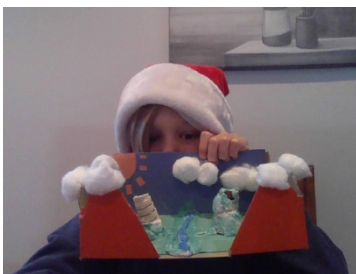
Notes:
