Due to the status of COVID-19 in the communities, all winter sports scrimmages and games, home and away, are cancelled through December 13th.

Allegheny Valley continues its practice of sponsoring an annual Holiday Art Contest. The winning images are used for the holiday cards sent by the District to partners throughout the community, around the area, and across the state. The District has received the results from the Legionella re-test at Springdale Jr-Sr High School. The District replaced hardware in six locations, which were then re-tested; three still have concentrations of Legionella. Cleaning, superheating, and running the water are the main recommendations from the testing company, with hyperchlorination of the affected areas as the next step. At this time, the District is consulting with a plumber to discuss options and assist with the matter. Once completed, the District will re-test these areas.
