## A Family-Friendly Weekly Update

According to the governor's mandate, anyone attending any activity inside a school district facility must wear a mask. All activities include those attending meetings (School Board Meetings, booster group meetings, etc.), events, and performances. In addition, all visitors to the buildings must wear masks to enter.

The Pennsylvania Department of Education has informed school districts of disruptions in the food and supplies chain affecting school nutrition programs. Issues include food and supply production, transportation and fuel cost, availability, and cost throughout the supply chain from our vendors. Some food or supply issues may cause adjustments to our daily menus based on product availability. In other words, some standard menu items may not be available for our students. Parents dropping off students at the high school are asked to utilize the student parking lot, the D-wing lot entrance, or the James Street circle. Parents are requested NOT to use the front driveway to drop off students at the main office/McGhee Fieldhouse.



The District stresses the importance of contacting the School Nurse directly. The District will gladly make a copy of the vaccination card.
