A reminder that the Allegheny Valley School District will be closed on Monday, September 6 in observance of the Labor Day holiday. Classes resume on Tuesday, September 7.

September 9 is scheduled as the District's first 2021-22 School-Community Night. Both buildings will be holding primarily virtual events. However, Acmetonia Elementary School will run an informational meeting on instrumental music, a pop-up Book Fair, and PTA meeting in person that evening. SHS families will have an opportunity to go period-by-period through their student's schedule, and families will be able to hear an overview of each course that their student takes. The group will then have a prompt for students to share or pass as they are comfortable. Support Circles will be held from 8:20-8:45 in the morning on a monthly basis. The first Support Circles will be held the week of September 13-17.

✓ The Acting Secretary of Pennsylvania's Department of Health issued an order requiring facemasks in public schools K to 12. This order is scheduled to take affect at 12:01 a.m. on September 7, 2021 and shall remain in effect until otherwise determined. For Allegheny Valley, this order means that the District will implement masking of all individuals for indoor events and activities.
