To provide additional communication for families on the re-opening of school, this short newsletter will be available each Friday.

Notes from Dr. Graczyk:

The District remains extremely encouraged with the opening of the 2020-2021 school year. We appreciate all of the patience and understanding that staff, students, and families have exhibited as we opened education online. As we look forward, we have planned for three phases: 1. Virtual, 2. Blended, and 3. Traditional w/ health & safety precautions.

The District will utilize these phases until we "phase out" and return to school without precautions. Currently, we plan to start the "blended phase" of instruction on Sept 21, 2020. However, a lot can change from now until then, thus like most information, our move to a "blended phase" is subject to change.

In an effort to keep our families updated, we want to provide information on the phased reopening of both Acmetonia Elementary School and Springdale Jr-Sr High School. Below, you will find specific information regarding the second phase: the blended phase.

- Students at both schools will attend school in either Cohort A or Cohort B.
- Students with a last name ending in A-L will attend school in-person on Monday and Thursday.
- Students with a last name ending in M-Z will attend school in-person on Tuesday and Friday.
- All students will work from home on Wednesday; this flexible day for students will allow some of the following to occur: individual instruction, group instruction, enrichment, remediation, parent meetings, etc.
- In order to best accommodate families, students living in the same household will be a part of the same cohort.
- Elementary teachers will be communicating students assigned cohorts through Seesaw on Wednesday, September 9, 2020. In the case that the elementary student(s) has/have a high school sibling(s), the students' cohort will be the same.
